



CODE OF PROFESSIONAL CONDUCT

In terms of public health, the environment and the economy, traffic safety is a major Australian issue.

The Australasian College of Road Safety exists to network professionals working in the field to assist them in maintaining standards and to promote road safety solutions which have been found to be effective.

Members of the Australasian College of Road Safety are expected to:

1. Promote the aims of the College as defined in its Constitution.
2. Maintains a standard of excellence in their safety specialty and to continue to upgrade their skills and training in that area.
3. Commit themselves to evaluation of programs and assessment of the environmental effects of those programs.
4. Share information freely about the implementation of safety programs.
5. Behave safely at all times.
6. Follow any codes of safe practice devised for their sections of the transport industry.
7. Encourage professionalism amongst all traffic safety workers.
8. Refrain from making unauthorised public statements on behalf of the College.
