



Code of Professional Conduct

The Australasian College of Road Safety exists to network all stakeholders working in the field to assist in maintaining standards and to promote road safety solutions which have been found to be effective.

Members, volunteers and employees of the Australasian College of Road Safety are expected to:

1. Promote the aims of the College as defined in its Constitution.
2. Maintains a standard of excellence in their safety specialty and continue to upgrade skills and training in that area.
3. Commit to evaluation of programs and assessment of the environmental effects of those programs.
4. Share information freely about the implementation of road safety programs.
5. Behave safely at all times.
6. Treat everyone with dignity and respect at all times.
7. Follow all codes of safe practice devised for relevant sectors of industry.
8. Encourage professionalism amongst all road safety stakeholders.
9. Refrain from making unauthorised public statements on behalf of the College.
